The changes of the Society, the need of new strategies and networks, and the messages to be sent are subsequently addressed.

- •Globalisation has challenged the world-wide geographic boundaries
- •Information technology has made, and continues to make, more information available
- •The diversity of society is challenging our traditional views and people skills
- •New technologies in engineering and construction
- •A common level of human safety and working conditions in Europe
- •An open market and increase of mobility of the contractors.
- •Enhanced public awareness of technical issues Civil infrastructure systems in Europe, United States and Japan are rapidly changing.
- •The changes of basic societal demand in terms of increased mobility and of sustainable development a better exploitation of networks.

- •New strategies for the development of the European networks
- The optimal investment for geo-hazards: Prevention versus Remediation
- Link between the scientific community and the industry: Precedents, Practices, Problems and Opportunites
- The role of decision-makers and Authorities for planning policies in the urban environment
- Education- problems related with the implementation of Sorbonne and Bolonha Declarations.

 - •Messages to Owners are related with need to reduce the risk of facilities such as buildings
 - •Messages to Decision-Makers stressing the role of engineering geotechnical for planning facilities and infrastructure and the consequences of occurrence of incidents and accidents.
 - •Messages to Public stressing the importance of geotechnical engineering for the development of modern societies
 - •The problematic of structural safety is huge and complex and need the co-operation of the Owners, Decision-Makers, Research Institutes, Designers, Constructors and General Public.
 - •These messages can be disseminated by a wide variety of publications including technical monographs, newsletters reports, workshops, seminar notes, TV programs, as well as multimedia slide sets, videotapes, CD-ROMs and web site-

One ironic situation that we are facing is that one of its glories "the revolutionary explosion of technology" has occurred so fast and with great optimism, that has ignored it dangers and none concerned with the adequate comprehension of the capacities. The scientists have developed outstanding devices, but had a few of opportunities to explore and to evaluate the consequences within a historic framework. Due to this circumstance the politicians have used these developments and algorithms without having an adequate idea

of the social and philosophical consequences. Simultaneously the technology revolution crashes with human conscience and the perception of the nature and the reality.

The last great change, the illuminism, has substituted the age of faith by a consistent experimentation and logic deduction, is now exceeded by the reliability of the algorithms offering better explanations.

To explore these new frontiers there is a need of great efforts from the leaders to narrow the gaps between the different worlds of technology, political, historic, social and philosophical.

I had the opportunity to endorse this message to the Conference delegates stressing the need of a reflection and alerting them for this situation.
